GOOD REASONS TO VISIT

- A jewel of 13th-century stained glass art (1,113 glass panels!).
- An architectural feat and a masterpiece of Rayonnant Gothic architecture.
- Located at the heart of historic Paris, close to Notre-Dame.

Louis IX had the Sainte-Chapelle built at the heart of his Parisian residence, the Palais de la Cité, in the mid-13th century.

Designed to serve as a monumental reliquary, it housed Christ's Crown of Thorns. Adorned with a unique collection of fifteen stained glass windows and a rose window effectively forming walls of light, the Sainte-Chapelle is the jewel in the French Rayonnant Gothic crown.

DID YOU KNOW...?

The current spire, which was rebuilt after the Revolution, is the fifth since it was originally built and its restoration inspired that of Notre-Dame de Paris.

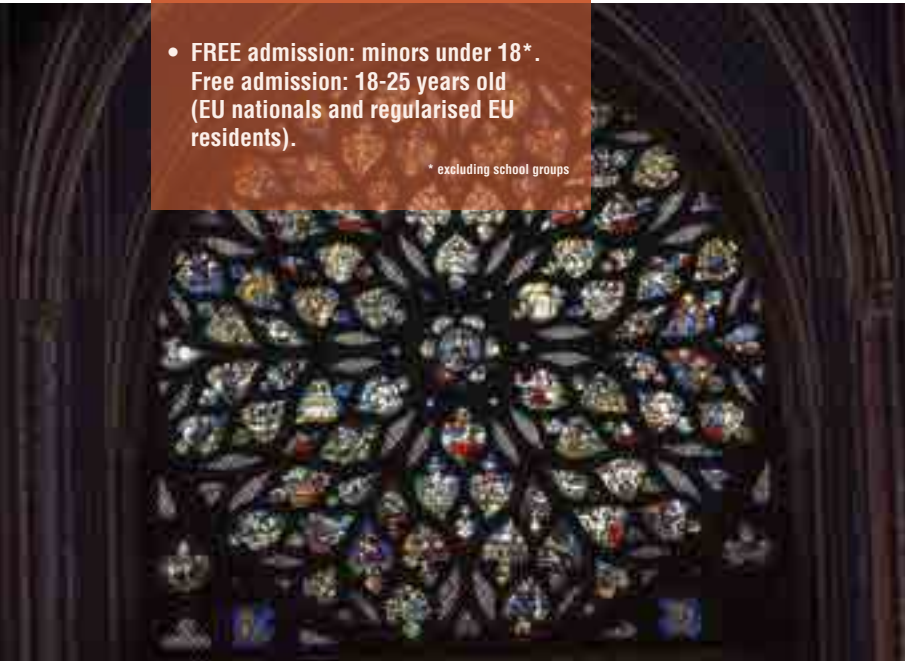
